TOYOTA Assembly Plant Tour



Looking for a good PA Day activity for the January 20, 2014 day off school?

Have you ever wanted to see how vehicles are built?

Why not join other ABC Peel families for a fascinating tour of the Toyota assembly plant in Cambridge, Ontario?

This guided tour will take you by tram through two assembly areas during active production.

ABC Peel will provide transportation by bus for the one hour drive from Mississauga to Cambridge and back. You will meet other ABC members and their families, and have an experience that is both interesting and educational.

Date: Monday, January 20, 2014

Time: 9:30am – 2:45pm. This will include a 45-minute stop for lunch (bring or buy your own).

Ages: 8 - Adult

Location: Meet at our bus pick-up area near Hurontario St. and Matheson Blvd., Mississauga. (Details provided with registration confirmation.)

Cost: \$18.00 per person (Adults and Children)

EVENT INFORMATION

This ABC Peel Family Event is a visit to the Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada (TMMC) assembly plant in Cambridge, Ontario. This an assembly site for some popular Toyota and Lexus automobiles, and it has built well over five million vehicles right here in Ontario. The visit includes a guided tour by tram of two assembly areas.

Who can participate?

Families who are members of ABC are invited to attend this event. Children must be 8 years of age or older and be accompanied by an adult, up to a maximum of three children per adult. Please note that ABC cannot supervise or admit any unaccompanied children.

When is it?

This event will be on January 20, 2014. This is a "Report Writing/Assessment Day" (**no school**) for most Elementary Schools in both the Peel and Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Boards. Plan to meet us for bus boarding at 9:30AM, and arrive back in Mississauga at about 2:45PM.

What about Lunch?

Before reaching Cambridge, the bus will stop for a lunch break at an ONroute Service Centre. You are free to either purchase lunch (Tim Horton's, Pizza-Pizza, Big Smoke Burger, Teriyaki Experience) or bring your own. This is an ideal time to socialize with other ABC member families. Please note that no eating or drinking is allowed on the bus.

What will I see at the Toyota Plant?

TMMC's tour guide will give a brief introduction about the plant. Then, the group will board a tram that will take us through a welding area and an assembly area. These are two of the most visually impressive shops at this site. The tour will be approximately an hour long.

Can I take pictures or video?

No: TMMC has strict rules regarding security and privacy. No electronic devices (such as cameras, cell phones, or iPods) may be brought on the tour. These devices must be checked in at the Visitor's Centre during the tour.

How do I register?

Due to the limited number of spots available on this tour, reservations are required. Avoid disappointment and book early!

To register:

- Read the attached Safety and Security Rules, and sign where indicated.
- Complete the attached Registration Form.
- Mail the completed Registration Form, signed Safety and Security Rules form, and cheque for full payment to ABC Peel Chapter, at the address on the Registration Form.
- EARLY-BIRD DISCOUNT: \$15 per person if your registration and payment are received by ABC Peel on or before December 27, 2013.
- All completed registration forms and cheques must be received by ABC Peel before January 10, 2014.

ABC Peel will confirm your registration by e-mail. If all spaces on the tour are filled before your payment arrives, you will be notified by e-mail, and your payment will not be processed.

SAFETY AND SECURITY RULES

IMPORTANT: Please carefully read these rules before registering to ensure entry to the plant.

All participants on the tour must agree to abide by certain rules by Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada that apply to all group tours.

Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada is an active manufacturing facility. The safety of all those who enter the plant is the first priority.

Along the tour, the trams will enter the Welding shop, where occasional welding sparks are present. While these sparks are not harmful, some fabrics are more easily flammable.

As a result, the following safety rules must be followed by all groups:

- 1. All tour participants must be a minimum of eight years of age.
- 2. No hats or scarves.
- 3. No cameras.
- 4. No cell phones, pagers, communication devices or MP3 players (lpods, etc.).
- 5. Only natural fibres may be worn in the plant (wool, cotton, silk, linen etc.)
 - No Polyester
 - No Rayon
 - No Acrylic
 - No Synthetic fibre (micro fibre)
- 6. No shorts, skirts, tear-away pants, nylon pants or tops.
- 7. All purses, bags, knapsacks must be left in the Visitor Centre under lock & key
- 8. Safety glasses must be worn at all times.
- 9. Arms and legs must be kept inside the tram at all times.
- 10. No food or drinks are allowed during the tour.

Additionally ABC Peel reminds you that parents or supervising adult must be responsible for children under their care during the entire day's event.

For security reasons, ABC Peel must provide to TMMC a list of every person on the tour one week ahead of time. For this reason, all registrations must be completed by January 10, 2014. No substitutions are possible after that time. We regret that no refunds can be made after January 9th, 2014, for any reason.
