The **Enrichment Mini-Course** (**EMC**), a one week residential program for high school students and **SEEDS (Seven-Eight Enrichment Days)-In-Residence** (**SIR**) program, a four day program for grade 7 & 8 students, allow students to study a challenging academic subject of their choosing at an advanced level in a university setting.


