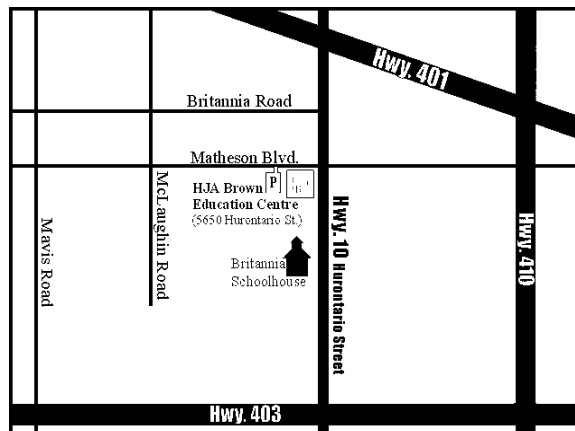
Those attending this Parent Night seminar will have an opportunity to interact and use some of the materials designed by the presenter.
